**Module 1: Information Literacy**

**Date: Monday, 2 February 2009, 10am-4pm**

**Venue: Arts and Social Studies Library (ASSL)**

This day will start with an introduction to Information Services at Cardiff University and to the role of subject librarians. The background to information literacy developments at Cardiff will be outlined, followed by a range of presentations on current IL initiatives at Cardiff (for example the Cephalonian Method for library inductions, the Handbook for Information Literacy Teaching, podcasts etc.). There will be plenty of time for discussion and the day will finish with an opportunity for our visitors to share approaches from their countries to developing information literacy.

**Module 2: Library Buildings, RFID**

**Date: Tuesday, 3 February 2009, 10am-4.30pm**

**Venue: various**

This day will focus on recent and current library building initiatives at Cardiff University and will include visits to a range of Site Libraries, amongst which will be Aberconway Library, the Sir Herbert Duthie Library and Trevithick Library. Our self-issue service using RFID and information on future library developments will also be included. The day will be rounded off with an opportunity to discuss specific questions and hear about library buildings projects in our visitors' countries.

**Module 3: Library Management, Electronic Journals, Eprints**

**Date: Wednesday, 4 February 2009, 10am-4pm**

**Venue: Arts and Social Studies Library**

This day will focus on library management, the structure and strategy of Cardiff University's Library Service, and current data storage, information discovery and delivery projects at Cardiff (e.g. portal, institutional repository, library catalogue enrichment, electronic journals, UK Research Reserve etc.). Time at the end of the day will allow for discussion and the exchange of ideas as well as the sharing of practices in our visitors' libraries.

**Module 4: SWEDIC**

**Date: Thursday, 5 February 2009, 10am-4pm**

**Venue: South Wales Europe Direct Information Centre (SWEDIC), Guest Building**

Ian Thomson, SWEDIC Director, will provide an introduction to the work of the South Wales Europe Direct Information Centre (SWEDIC) and the associated European Documentation Centre (EDC), the most substantial source of European information expertise in Wales. There will also be an introduction to the online information service, *European Sources Online*, one of the largest such services published by a university in Europe. ESO is edited from and published by Cardiff University Library.
